Courses will be held at **Saint Joseph Hospital, Mullen Building, Board Room**, 1895 Franklin, Denver, (Go to www.mapquest.com to print a map). Parking may be available in the parking garage on 20th and Lafayette for a small fee; or you can find free parking several blocks to the north of the building. The Mullen Building is north of the hospital's twin towers, on the West side of Franklin. Maximum class size is 24. *During class sessions, all cell phones must be turned off. You may make phone calls during the breaks to avoid disruption to other participants.* Participants must register for the complete four-day course. Partial registrations will not be accepted. The deadline for registration is March 20, 2007. Total cost for the course is **\$450** and includes class materials, lunches, and refreshments. PROOF OF IDENTITY REQUIREMENTS

The State is requiring that all registrants must prove identity to receive a certificate of completion of the Administrator training. At the first class, please show a current Colorado's Driver's License, Current Colorado non-driver identification card; current US federal, state or local government-issued identification (US federal, state or local government-issued identification (including military); current tribal enrollment card with photo or other form of photo tribal identification; current passport, or current student identification. Copies will be kept on file. Individuals will be required to sign a State Approved Form documenting they have shown proof of identity.
